



Figure 4. Age-adjusted death rates for the 10 leading causes of death in 2019: United States, 2018 and 2019






# Helping the individual help themself








Self reported likelihood to call 911 to report individual as suicidal Is this explained by differences in perceived suicide risk?

Self reported likelihood to call 911 to report individual as dangerous Is this explained by differences in perceived danger to others?




