TRANSFER OF CREDIT: Students entering with an MA in a psychology-related field may be eligible for up to 45 credits blanket transfer providing that the MA was earned within the last five years and the student maintained a "B" average. This reduces the required credits to 90 credits, but students will still need to complete 3 years of coursework.
